The circular dichroism (CD) of a chiral molecule in a crystal is a complex function of both molecule and environment, and has been investigated in a variety of systems. Some notable general trends have emerged from these studies. Chiral crystals generally show larger induced CD's than achiral ones, and near enantiomeric substances show relatively more CD than do the enantiomers as a whole. In addition, since small changes in molecular structure can alter the observed CD, the number of independent data points that must be collected in order to achieve an accurate assessment of a given compound's CD has been increased by some 30-40%.

Recently, we reported observations of stronger CD induction in organic chiral crystals than in organic achiral ones. We have made such observations in the case of diosmine (4-O-beta-D-apiosyl-(1-->2)-alpha-L-rhamnosyl-(1-->6)-beta-D-glucoside) and in this communication continue the study of this observation. Here we describe tests we performed to develop methods for quantifying the chiral response of crystals. The results of these tests show that CD of diosmine crystals is largely independent of the frequency and orientation of light incident on the sample and that such crystals are optically homogeneous when excited by steady state or pulsed laser light.
