I want to just use the same code I do for adding the data but just be able to delete the data if it exists. My database is set up like this A: If you look at your existing database, you'll see that the root is a column called "colleges", which contains a list of the user's colleges. This means that deleting the database entry can be done by getting the colleges column, removing the entry and calling setValue on the database reference. // Get the colleges root node.
