A: I know this question has an accepted answer, but I wanted to add in that I don't think this works from within a browser, and instead you have to download the exe, to be able to scan your entire computer. I downloaded the exe and followed the steps and it worked just fine. Hope that helps :) Q: How to set execution time limit for a job in CBM To run a job for a long time (above than 5 hours) I have made a cronjob. But the problem is that it does not work. Why? I have set it manually, it can run 4.5 hours (5 hours is the default). If the job takes more than 5 hours then it should wait for 5 hours and then run again. A: According to schedule's description, it seems the default is 5 hours. If you want to set another limit, please try to remove the `ExecuteScheduleAtTimeInFuture` from there.
