Chess is played by two people, it consists in attacking and defending the same piece, called king, for an agreed period of time. The goal of the game is to checkmate the opponent king. Because it can be done in fewer moves than the number of pieces, chess is considered one of the most demanding games. The games has an impressive history, it was played by the great masters such as Mikhail Filtvintchik, Jacques M. Maubachin, José Raúl Capablanca, Anatoly Karpov, Bobby Fischer, Garry Kasparov, Vasily Smyslov, Michel Bonnet, Alexei Dreev, Larry Parr, David Morris, etc. All pieces are controlled by two players: white and black, and the white player tries to remain the black. Each player has 64 pieces (excluding the king). Pawns are the weakest pieces in the game, but they are the most mobile. They can move one step at each time, their purpose is to get nearer to the king and then capture it. The other pieces are the rook, queen, bishop one, a queen two and a knight one. The king can move only one and defend it with the pieces. Chess was a popular pastime among the rich and powerful, it was considered a useful skill in the court, where all useful information was systematically collected through spies.
