

A key combination of keys on your keyboard is used to invoke shortcuts. Depending on the selection you are making, shortcuts may be listed the hemou or be listed separately as an icon on your screen. Depending on the shortcut key combination, your menu and toolbars may change. We've listed the keyboard shortcuts in the following sections: Menu Shortcuts Moving around within the drawing and selecting an item or function is one of the most used menu shortcuts are listed below. M → Moving Command L → Left Shift → Selecting Shift J → Selection box A key on your keyboard, used to select a specific type of entity. You may select items individually or you may select a series of items at once. The shortcut key combination can be used to quickly select multiple objects (Shift + A). Or, you can simply select objects one at a time using the mouse (M). Q → Quitting/Exit Command K → Undo Command Z → Zoom to selection Command W → Wait for command to finish Toolbar Shortcuts The toolbar is a collection of icons and buttons that reside on the left-hand side of your screen and are typically available only when you are using a drawing tool. In AutoCAD, there are three types of toolbar items: main, substream, and streamline. Let's discuss each in turn. Main toolbar: These are the icons that are available to you even when you are not currently using a drawing or on a floating toolbar, you can always click and hold the mouse button in order to move the mouse cursor to the desired location. Pressing and holding the mouse button will invoke the shortcut keys. Substream toolbar: The substream
